



DEMOLITION PLAN AND PROPOSED PLAN





Proposed plan

Walls planned to be demolished is shown on the existing plan with red color with the purpose of enhancing the living room and the kitchen areas.


Walls planned to be built is shown on the proposed plan with green color. The living room turned into the bedroom and the added walls created a bathroom and a wardrobe

EXISTING AND PROPOSED DESIGN






We proposed an alternative design solution in case of the walls are not allowed to changed or demolished.

In the proposed design the kitchen + living room area is more spacious and walk in wardrobe is one of the added benefits for a small apartment.


FURNITURE PLAN


KITCHEN-LIVING ROOM-BALCONY SECTION A-A

Because the flat is small, for the more spacious look the living room and the kitchen are designed as a studio. The chosen blue color ensures the neutrality and the cozyness of the space. The wooden look of the kitchen visually separates these two places. Despite being very compact, the balcony includes a soft seating area with the storage space underneath.

ENTRANCE HALL-KITCHEN SECTION B-B



We preferred a minimalistic design to create an open space as an entrance does not have a direct lighting. We used a light green color for the same reason and separated the hal from the kitchen with a doorway to provide indirect sunlight from main room.















BALCONY-LIVING ROOM SECTION C-C



We used the wall between two doors as a TV wall, By using whiter color we kept this wall as simple as possible for a transitional space between the rooms and creating a cinema projector effect.

We designed the window sill as a seating area in the bedroom and used the soft beige color for a cozier and warmer feel. By keeping the curtains light both in living room and the bedroom, we ensured the luminosity of the whole flat.

With that idea in mind, we kept the materials very natural looking.











BATHROOM SECTION F-F; G-G






